Based on the features of the route, Taichung Tour Bus gets paints on the exterior, leading tourists to a new experience of travel.

- 153 Guguan Route Line** (Exploring the Mountains): THSR Taichung Station ↔ Guguan. Around every 25-60 minutes.
- 66V Dakeng Route Line** (Wandering along the Seaside): VL | Songzhu Station > Dakeng. Around every 60-90 minutes.
- 309 Gaomei Wetland Route Line** (Strolling through the Villages): Single Circular Route. Taichung Station ↔ Gaomei Wetland.
- 151 Wufeng Route Line** (Tour of Taiwan Tourist Shuttle): Taichung City Council ↔ Chaoyang University of Technology. Around every 20-30 minutes.
- 888 Fengyuan-Houli Route** (Tour of Taiwan Tourist Shuttle): Fengyuan Transfer Center ↔ Taian Station. Around every 25-60 minutes.
- 11 Taichung Midtown Bus Loop** (Tour of Taiwan Tourist Shuttle): Left Bus Loop (Taichung Station (Chenggong Intersection)) and Right Bus Loop (Taichung Station (Minzu Intersection)).

### 153 Guguan-Light Travel for All Seasons

Shihgang District Office Station

**SPOT1 Dongfeng Bicycle Green Way**: Cycling route full of green atmosphere with beautiful landscape all the route. It is suggested to rent a bicycle to enjoy the green way. Around 20 minutes by bus. Additional 8 minutes on foot.

**SPOT2 Dongshi Hakka Cultural Park**: The museum showcases a collection of Hakka artifacts, along with periodic exhibitions dedicated to these cultural treasures. Additionally, visitors have the opportunity to indulge in a variety of delectable Dongshi local snacks. Around 1 hour and 20 minutes by bus. Additional 2 minutes on foot.

**SPOT3 Guguan Museum**: Helping tourists understand the mountains, forests, and springs in Guguan to open up the real experience of sensation before entering Guguan. Around 2 minutes on foot.

### 309 Gaomei-Tour of Coastal Beauty

Zhongqing-Wuguan S. Intersection Station

**SPOT1 Qingshui Art Village**: Several of the buildings in the family village have been successfully preserved, while the park has undergone a revitalization process that incorporates distinct artistic and heritage elements. Around 30 minutes by bus.

**SPOT2 Wugu Fishing Port**: It is a comprehensive leisure fishing port with production, sales tourism and entertainment and provides the freshest seafood as well as cooking service. Around 10 minutes by bus. Additional 20 minutes on foot or 5 minutes by Ubike.

**SPOT3 Gaomei Wetland**: It has abundant intertidal zone, wetland ecology, and beautiful view of sunset. It is a wonderful view that everyone must visit at least once in their life. The opening hours of wooden walkway will be slightly adjusted according to the sea situation. Around 40 minutes by bus. Additional 5 minutes on foot.

### 151 Wufeng Route Line-A Century of Glory

Asia University Ando Museum Station

**SPOT1 Asia University Museum of Modern Art**: The museum is widely recognized as a significant global landmark, exhibiting a diverse collection of contemporary artworks and a unique architectural design. Around 5 minutes by bus. Additional 5 minutes on foot.

**SPOT2 Guangfu New Village**: A military dependents' village full of cultural and creative art atmosphere. It is a dream base for the youth. Around 8 minutes by bus.

**SPOT3 Assembly Affairs Park (The Legislative Yuan)**: As the cultural heritage, Taiwan Provincial Consultative Council served as a democratic environmental education place in the early years. Around 5 minutes by bus. Additional 5 minutes on foot.

### 66V Dakeng-Mountain Trail Trekking Adventure

Dakeng Trail No.9 Station

**SPOT1 Dakeng Trail No.9 Jib.0**: The beginner's trail, characterized by its dense woodland, offers an ideal setting for parents and children to enjoy. Additionally, on holidays, a farmer's market is conveniently located at the trail's endpoint, showcasing and selling a variety of locally sourced agricultural products. Around 6 minutes by bus. Additional 2 minutes on foot.

**SPOT2 Carton King**: Experience a captivating parent-child tour at the Carton King, centered around the theme of paper. Immerse yourself in the boundless world of creativity as we explore the limitless possibilities of paper, lighting your imagination. Around 25 minutes by bus. Additional 20 minutes on foot.

**SPOT3 Dakeng Ecological Park**: The site is widely recognized for its ecological education significance, and during the transition from spring to summer, it draws numerous tourists who are captivated by the enchanting presence of fluttering butterflies. Around 35 minutes by bus. Additional 4 minutes on foot.

**SPOT4 Wufeng Lin Family Mansion and Garden**: Lin Family is one of the key families in Taiwan during Qing Dynasty. Lin Family mansion and the Fuchou-style stage/Dahua Hall are models of traditional architecture. Around 12:00-17:00 (Saturday to Sunday 09:00-16:00).

**SPOT4 Zongzhan Night Market**: The Zongzhan Night Market offers a vibrant atmosphere with a diverse selection of food and game booths, providing an ideal setting for gatherings among families and friends. Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Sunday: 17:00-00:00; Saturday: 17:00-00:30.
